SPACES

MOA's spaces are available for rental from 5 to 11pm on any evening, except Thursdays when we are open late to the public. With your rental, we offer exclusive access to all the galleries of the Museum. Food and drink may be served in the Lobby, Courtyard Room and adjacent Outdoor Courtyard, in the Haida House, or on our stunning Museum Grounds with ocean view.

GREAT HALL

No food or drink are permitted in the Great Hall, but it offers excellent acoustics and a breathtaking setting for dance, drama and musical performances, or for keynote presentations or special words of welcome. The Great Hall can accommodate approximately 200 seated or 300 standing, audience-style.

LOBBY

MOA's Lobby at the main entrance, adjacent the MOA Shop, is a food service-permitted space. This is ideal for a welcoming station for guest arrival. The Lobby can accommodate approximately 100 reception-style.

COURTYARD ROOM

By day, the Courtyard Room serves as MOA's café; by night, these retail elements are designed to hide away. The Courtyard Room becomes a blank slate on which to plan your chosen design. The café counter may be used as a ready-made bar space and the café furnishings are available to evening rental events, as desired. The Courtyard Room can accommodate approximately 100 reception-style or 70 dinner-style.

OUTDOOR COURTYARD

The Outdoor Courtyard adjacent to the Courtyard Room is surrounded by soaring cedars and hemlocks. The space can be tented (40' x 40' or 40' x 60') or can be used open-air for receptions, parties or corporate gatherings. MOA's Outdoor Courtyard can accommodate approximately 120 dinner-style or 160 reception-style.

HAIDA HOUSE

MOA's unique and beautiful Haida House was created by artists Bill Reid and Doug Cranmer, and can be used for intimate meetings or dinners, or as a quiet contemplative space in a larger evening's event. The Haida House's unique shape can accommodate approximately 40 dinner-style, 100 reception-style, or 80 to 120 audience-style.

MUSEUM GROUNDS HILLTOP

The largest food-permitted space at MOA, the outdoor tent-able Hilltop can be tented to over 10,000 square feet (tent 25 x 40 metres maximum). Due to its proximity to neighbouring homes, the Museum Grounds Hilltop is not suitable for events featuring amplified music, but is ideal for conference and corporate banquets which showcase MOA's unrivalled views of Howe Sound and the Northshore Mountains.
